## MOSQUITO CONTROL

The City of Conway Public Works Department stated Mosquito Control spraying will start on June 1<sup>st</sup> and will continue until September. They come through municipal areas between 4 am and 6 am. The POA cannot schedule a date or time for spraying. Perhaps by the time this Newsletter goes out, we will have already been sprayed for Mosquito Control. However, at all times we need to recognize that standing water on our property is a mosquito magnet. Here are just a few standing water catchers you might not think of: empty bottles and cans, birdbaths and pet bowls, water buckets and clogged rain gutters. Put anything that can hold rainwater away after use and attend to the things that are inviting those pesky critters to your house.

## GRASS CLIPPINGS AND STORM DRAINS DON'T MIX!



With summertime comes the mowing season. It is important to remember not to blow grass clippings into the street. Grass clippings in the street ultimately end up in a storm drain. Yard debris, including leaves and other organic plant material like shrubbery trimmings and grass clippings, are a significant source of stormwater pollution.

The primary purpose of storm drains is to carry rainwater away from developed areas to prevent flooding. When you blow your lawn waste into the street, it can clog storm drains and cause drainage and flooding issues.\*\* *Make sure you tell your lawn care contractor not to blow grass into the street.*
